



SDCT GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
November 15, 2018

President Fred Schilling

- Fred called the meeting to order at 6:30 and welcomed everyone. He thanked the Borkowski's for the birthday cake and read the list of members with November birthdays.
- He pointed out that the voting for our 2019 BOD officers ends tonight, and that paper ballots are available for anyone present who needs one.
- He then thanked the members who participated in the Veteran's Day parade and Donna Payton gave a report on the event. SDCT had 7 cars participating, with Mike Peterson organizing the participants and Bob Koblewski taking photos. Bob reported that anyone wishing to have a copy of any of the photos should contact him. Donna reported that it was very well organized and that they had a very good time.
- Next Fred mentioned the London Bridge Corvette Show and had Dick Holdeman report on it. Dick reported that there were over 75 Corvettes on the bridge with a drone flying over to take photos of each of the drivers standing by their car. The Holdemans were joined by Jim Garbarino in the event.
- Fred announced that there will be no GMM in December or November due to the Holiday Party and the Social Social.

Activities Director Marcia Schilling

- Marcia reminded everyone that the deadline for menu selections for the Holiday Party is Nov. 30, and that both the selections and checks should be sent to Kurt Bassett.
- She also reported that the deadline for donations for the Charity Raffle is Nov. 26.
- Marcia reminded everyone that the Social Social is set for Jan. 5, and we will have a few more cruises in December and in January.

Treasurer Kurt Bassett

- Kurt announced that the books are balanced and we are doing very well financially. He reminded everyone to send any checks to him via the P.O Box for security reasons.

Membership Director Bob Johnson

- Bob reported that in 2018 we had 118 regular members and 4 honorary members, and that so far for 2019 we have 98 regular members and 4 honorary members. The drop in membership is largely due to members moving out of the area or health issues.
- Bob also reported on the Kickoff Event. At present we have 40 registered participants and the finances are fine. He shared photos of the shirt which will be given out and the raffle prizes we have so far. We have also received the \$500 donation from Watson Chevrolet and a kit of goodies from Summit Racing. Watson has also promised items for the goody bags.
- He also reported to the membership that Barb Johnson will be the new RE for the Roadrunner Region and that he will be the RCD. He reported on the Governor's message from Paul Hamersly, informing

everyone that their new NCCC cards will be arriving by mail in early January. He told everyone about the NCCC National Convention in Denver in July, which will celebrate the 60th anniversary of the NCCC. NCCC currently has 18,698 members.

- Breck reported that the Museum is quiet at this time, but members are urged to check the museum website for items in their gift shop.
- He also shared the sad news that Jim Gray – one of the founders of TCC – has passed away. More details will follow as far as arrangements.

- Bob K. will bring a video of the caravan he participated in several years ago to the Social Social so everyone will get an idea of the activities.
